Students across the country in preschool through grade 12 have been participating in the program for almost 40 years. Reflections offers students the opportunity to create works of art for fun and recognition.

If you have a student in your advisory or one of your classes who has interest in writing, artwork, photography, dance, film making, or music, then your encouragement may help them to enter the Reflections Program. However, no advice or corrections may be made by a teacher, parent, or by peer editing. An artist statement must tie their work into the theme, “Wow!”

Entries are due January 6, 2009 and should be dropped off in the office.

An official entry form must accompany each entry. Entry forms and rules for each of the six categories (visual arts, literature, musical composition, photography, dance choreography, and film production) are available on the bulletin board in the back of the office. These rules must be followed by the students to make sure their work can be accepted. Each entry must be the original work of one student only.

Gilbert H. Hood Middle School will have a Reflections Show on the evening of January 20, 2009 at 7 PM. The NH State Exhibit (for winners from each school) is also at GHHMS on Monday, March 16 from 6:30 to 8:30 PM.
